Tuition Fees cover tuition, exercise books, stationery, most College camps and excursions.

Fees and discounts are reviewed and set annually by the Board and are subject to change.

Fee and payment terms are outlined in full in the NT Christian Schools [Fee Policy](#) available on our College website under the 'Our School' tab or from the campus administration office.

NT Christian Schools reserves the right to cancel enrolment if fees remain unpaid for more than one term.

What are Sibling Discounts?

Sibling Discounts are applicable to families who have more than one child enrolled in Transition to Year 12 at any campus of NT Christian Schools. The 1st student is the eldest child enrolled. (See Fee Policy for full terms and conditions).

1st child = 0% discount

2nd child = 35% discount for that child

3rd child = 75% discount for that child

4th child = 90% discount for the 4th child (and subsequent children)

How are College tuition fees paid?

NT Christian Schools and Araluen Christian College manage all school fees and charges through FACTS, our online fee management system. FACTS provides families with flexible payment plan options and convenient online account access, allowing you to view account balances, monitor payments, and update personal and financial information at any time.

When will I be billed?

The 2027 tuition fee is invoiced in October 2026. FACTS will issue an email notifying you of the payment plan for 2027. You can log into FACTS using the link below to choose a flexible payment plan to suit your family's needs.

Is there a discount if I pay my fees in full early?

Yes, an early payment discount of 5% is applicable to the tuition fees (gross total fees and sibling discounts) if paid in full by **Monday, 8 February 2027**. For families who commence during the year, the 5% early payment discount is applicable if the tuition fees are paid within 20 days of the student/s commencement date.

How can I use the NT Government Back to School Payment Voucher?

Currently, the NT Government offers a \$200 Back to School Voucher per child per year from Transition to Year 12. This Voucher can be used for the following:

- Tuition Fees
- College Uniforms

Back to School Vouchers are issued at the start of Term 1, are only applicable to students who are enrolled at the College in Term 1 and need to be redeemed during the same school term.

What if my child leaves prior to the end of term or at the end of the school year?

Parents/guardians are required to provide a term (10 school-weeks) written notice to the college if they will be withdrawing their child's enrolment prior to graduation. Failure to provide appropriate notice will result in an early departure fee being charged, equivalent to 10 weeks of tuition fees.

What is an Enrolment Acceptance Deposit?

Enrolment Acceptance Deposits of \$150 for each primary school aged student and \$300 for each secondary school aged student who is offered an enrolment in a college, is to be paid to confirm acceptance of and hold their enrolment place.

Enrolment Acceptance Deposits are applied to the family's account as payment towards Tuition Fees at the commencement of attendance.

Enrolment Acceptance Deposits are non-refundable if the student does not commence enrolment as anticipated, except at the Principal's discretion, where extenuating circumstances can be shown to be outside of the parent's control.
